If you're involved in Rescue, please compare the **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** with other throwable water rescue tools.

- Buoyancy:** Devices possessing sufficient reach do not have sufficient buoyancy.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – 12 pounds* Others: _____ pounds
- Reach:** Existing devices with sufficient buoyancy do not possess sufficient reach.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – 100 feet Others: _____ feet
- Rapid Deployment:** Any device slow in deployment is unacceptable with a survival window of 60 seconds or less.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – 10 seconds Others: _____ seconds
- Re-deployment:** Under intense stress a device must not be difficult to deploy/re-deploy in the event of a missed first throw.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – 45 seconds or less Others: _____ seconds
- Non-injurious:** To encourage training and practice, no device can possess a high injury potential during non-emergency training events, let alone a rescue.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – Soft outer foam cover Others: Yes / No / Not sure
- Simplicity:** Any device that is too complicated for the average user will likely lead to panic and failure at the moment it is needed most.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – Under 1 hour training for most. Others: Simple / Complex
- Portability:** Any cumbersome device that doesn't travel easily in a small boat / vehicle is unlikely to be available when needed.
● **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** – 17 x 3 inches & 1.5 pounds, self contained spool and rope
Others: _____ inches & _____ pounds, _____ rope storage

Additional Item:

- Wind penetration:** Any device must be able to cover the drowning zone of 30 to 70 feet from shore.
● Log on to LIFE-SAFER's website to see the **PERSONAL RETRIEVER™** at full extension, directly into 15-knot winds.

*The US / UK accept 50 Newton / 11 pounds of buoyancy now required in the Type 50 Buoyancy Aids as sufficient to keep a conscious person afloat.
